No candidate running for office shall have access to 12 ballots or results prior to the conclusion of the election. The final results shall be 13 announced in each educational unit. NTEA Officers shall be elected in April/May, and 14 shall assume office, with the exception of the President, at the end of the school year or 15 when negotiations are completed.
