

Title: ELCs are Separate Worksites

Intent: (Including any statement about the intent or aim of this amendment)

For a variety of reasons, Early Learning Centers should be deemed separate worksites for the purpose of members at those centers nominating and electing their own Building representatives. ELC have different start and end times than the K-5 elementary buildings, Most ELCs (3 of 4) are a separate building, the certificated employees at ELCs have different supervisors and ESA staff from the K-5 buildings, have different meeting availability times, and other factors that make them very different from K-5 buildings.

Cost implications: None to minimal due to a couple of possible added Building Rep positions.

Recommended amendment language:

Inclusion of PGES-ELC, MES-ELC, MVES-ELC, and WES-ELC as separate “sites” (as defined in the NTEA Constitution in Article VII – Representative Council, Section 2.) in NTEA Bylaws Article XVII – SITES AND GROUPS.
